**Service Bulletin – RPM Transportation, Inc.  
Interrupted Service - Central California Coastal Region**

Due to the recent heavy rains and subsequent mud slides in the last 2 days, a 13.1 mile stretch of California Hwy 101 extending from the intersection of State Route 150 in Carpinteria to the intersection of Milpas Street in the heart of Santa Barbara remains closed due to mud and debris covering the roadway.

Initial reports provided by Caltrans indicated the closure to last through Thursday January 11<sup>th</sup> and these reports are now indicating closure until at least Monday January 15<sup>th</sup>.

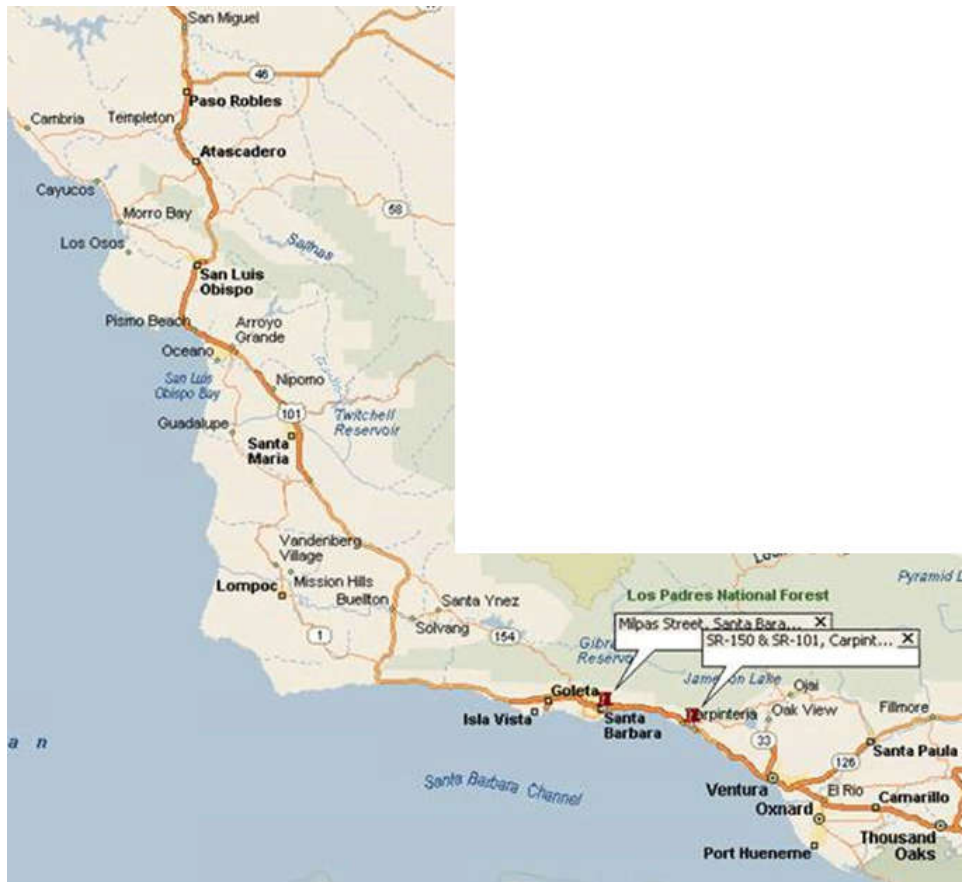

Shipments tendered to RPM Transportation to service points north of Carpinteria for all cities along the 101 up to and including Paso Robles have been held at this time and will not be delivered until such time as the 101 is accessible. Although there is limited access from the north through SR-46 for emergency equipment and commuter services, RPM Transportation will not be delivering via that route.

We will continue to monitor and update as new information is available.
