Effective Date: August 1, 2017  
Current TMF per 20' container: \$70.49  
New TMF per 20' container: \$72.09

Valued business partners:

The Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach California announced a 2.3% increase to the Traffic Mitigation Fee (TMF) to become effective Tuesday, August 1, 2017. TMF fees are assessed by 20' increment and will be increasing from \$70.49 to \$72.09 per 20' container, and from \$140.98 to \$144.18 per 40' & 45' container. The TMF is charged on containers moved on weekdays between 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

The TMF charge is a pass through expense (when necessary) and is not a negotiated item under contract of RPM Harbor Services, Inc.'s contract agreements. RPM Harbor Services, Inc. encourages every customer moving International containers through these ports to hold their own PierPass account as this makes managing these fees quick and efficient when the need to charge for this service is required.
